



# MAINTENANCE INSTRUCTIONS

## Xrange Ice

The most unusual feature of this surface is the cross-ground structure with an exceptional look and feel.

The cross-grinding is particularly obvious because of the gloss of the hard chrome-plated surface.

Please note that any wet spots should always be wiped up.

\* Please apply Sigolin to a cloth before you use it. Do not spray it directly on the surface.

\*\* The improper use of chemical decalcifiers may destroy the surface of stainless steel.

### CARE OF SPECIAL SURFACES

A damp microfiber cloth and/or a cleaner such as Sipuro are generally sufficient to clean IceDesign products. We recommend using a coarse-pored special sponge if there is extensive soiling. Rinse well if you use cleaners such as lemonstone or lemonstone balsam and Do not leave cleaning products longer than 10 min. without wiping off. Products containing salt, such as liquid soap or handwash, must be removed immediately. Please do not treat the surface with aggressive hydrochloric, hydrofluoric or nitric acid.



### WATER REMOVAL AND DESCALING

Best is to clean and dry the surfaces of your product as soon as possible after use. If water spots or limescales are created, these can be removed best using lemon stone or vinegar.




### FILM OR EXTRANEIOUS RUST

Proper and regular care helps to avoid film rust. However, should you discover film rust in spite of this, it can be removed excellently using our lemon stone.



### HOT PANS

Red-hot pots and pans must always be placed on a glass-ceramic surface or a potholder, not on stainless steel (tip: our Inox pad is an ideal potholder). Too extreme heat can change the product surface, even damage and/or discolor it.
